1. HEALTH & SAFETY POLICY STATEMENT

The Seaside Schools maintains a continuously reviewed, whole-school Health and Safety framework designed to ensure that our premises remain safe, secure, and conducive for learning.

We believe every child has the right to feel safe, protected, comfortable, and emotionally supported while at school.

We therefore commit to:

- Providing a safe and stimulating learning environment.
- Ensuring that all staff, students, and visitors understand and uphold safety protocols.
- Embedding safety consciousness into our school culture as part of character development, responsibility, and excellence.

2. PLANNING FOR SAFETY

We adopt a proactive, whole-school approach to safety planning. Before the start of every term, all teaching and non-teaching staff participate in a 2-day Safety Orientation Programme designed to strengthen understanding, alignment, and preparedness.

The programme includes:

- A review of existing safety protocols.
- Updates on new safety procedures, tools, and expectations.
- Clarifications on roles and responsibilities in emergency or safety-related situations.

- A 5-member Safety Team is selected each term (2 teaching staff and 2 admin staff), working closely and reporting to the Head of Schools. Their mandate includes supervision, training reinforcement, and ensuring compliance across the school.

3. FIRE SAFETY & FIRE HAZARDS MANAGEMENT

To protect lives and property, The Seaside Schools maintains an active fire safety system:

Fire Safety Expectations

- Teachers educate students regularly about fire hazards and emergency behaviour.
- Fire evacuation drills are conducted once every session to build awareness and readiness.
- Fire evacuation procedures are visibly displayed in all classrooms, offices, and strategic points.
- Fire alarms, extinguishers, and safety equipment are inspected regularly.

4. DOORS, WINDOWS & LOCKS

All doors, windows, and locks are routinely inspected to ensure student safety, controlled access, and safeguarding expectations. Any malfunction must be reported immediately to the Admin Department for prompt correction.

5. PLAY & SPORTING EQUIPMENT SAFETY

The selection, installation, and maintenance of all play and sporting equipment is supervised by the Head of Administration (HoA), Facility Officer and Physical and Health Education HOD.

Safety measures include:

- Regular maintenance of sporting fields, lawns, and play areas to remove hazards.
- Use of rubber matting or artificial grass to minimise injuries from falls.
- Installation of climbing frames or ladders where required.
- Continuous supervision during all playtimes, students are never left unattended during sports or outdoor play.

6. VISITOR MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

Ensuring the safety of students and staff requires strict monitoring of all visitors on school premises. Our Visitor Management System is continuously upgraded to enhance safeguarding.

Visitor Guidelines

1. All visitors must identify themselves at the security post.
2. Entry is granted only if the visitor has:
 - A confirmed appointment, or
 - A legitimate enquiry assessed by the Chief Security Officer or Head of Administration.
3. The CSO/HoA may direct an Admin Officer or Teacher on Duty to attend to a visitor where necessary.
4. Contractors must comply with search procedures and are only permitted to work after school hours or weekends, where possible.
5. All visitors must:
 - Sign in and out in the appropriate register
 - Wear a Visitor or Contractor tag
 - Read the school's Child Protection leaflet
 - Refrain from entering classrooms or offices without proper identification especially during school hours
6. Any individual posing a risk will be asked to leave the premises immediately.

7. GENERAL HEALTH & SAFETY PRINCIPLES

The Seaside Schools is committed to the wellbeing of every child and adult on campus. Our general principles include:

- Promoting good hygiene, cleanliness, and safe behaviour.
- Ensuring all staff act as role models, demonstrating responsibility and maintaining a safety-first mindset.
- Ensuring respect is shown to all staff members, including security and admin personnel, who play essential roles in maintaining safe operations.
- Maintaining calm, clear communication and preventing personal disagreements or offence from interfering with safety responsibilities.
- Encouraging early reporting of hazards, damage, or safety concerns to the Admin Department.
- Ensuring all safety guidelines are followed with discipline, cooperation, and professionalism.
